In 2006 as part of the development of a 9-spot Coal Seam Methane pilot at Bibblewindi, south of Narrabri, NSW, Eastern Star Gas Limited procured and installed a Universal SCADA well monitoring system from CS Gas Pty Ltd together with well head skids for each well.

The systems include 20Kw, 25Kw and 30Kw variable speed drives and report the data by radio back to a central control centre in Narrabri from where it is accessible in real time via the net from our head office in Sydney.

The down hole sensors are set at approximately 960m below ground level.

Eastern Star Gas Limited has been extremely pleased with the system as installed and the service provided by CS Gas and Universal in response to problems which have arisen from time to time. It is intended that the system will be built upon as the gas fields at Bibblewindi and Bohena are further developed.
